Election

The election procedure for the Executive Board shall be as follows:

- 1. The Vice President will administer all elections and chair the temporary election board.
- 2. Unless approved by the Executive Board and the Department, the election board is comprised of the entire Council barring any who is running for the position concerned.
- 3. The election for Executive Board positions is held once a year 3 weeks prior to the end of the Fall semester.
- 4. Before an election is held, an email will be sent to all members who are eligible to fill the open position(s). Interested members must reply in writing with a short (500 word maximum) platform to be distributed to the voting body. Interested members will have no less than five business days to respond.
- 5. Members may only run for one position.
- 6. Voting is open to the entire Council for a minimum of 5 business days after all platforms from candidates are received and made available to the Council.
- 7. Special elections can be held upon agreement between the Department and the incumbent Executive Board. Modified election procedure can be followed upon passing by a majority vote of the incumbent Board and agreement from the Department.
- 8. All elected Executive Board Officers must sign the GEEC code of conduct before they may perform any of their duties.
